Resolution to Allow Local Residents to Protest in Writing

Whitewater Township
Grand Traverse County

Whereas, the Township of Whitewater desires to ease the burden on taxpayers, the Assessor and the Board of Review and to ensure that all taxpayers have an equal opportunity to be heard by the Board of Review, the Township of Whitewater hereby resolves, according to provisions of MCL 211.30 (7) of the General Property Tax Act, that the Board of Review shall receive letters of protest regarding assessments from resident taxpayers from the first Tuesday in March until it adjourns from the public hearings for which it meets to hear such protests.

All notices of assessment change and all advertisements of Board of Review meetings are to include a statement that the resident taxpayers may protest by letter to the Board.

Now Therefore Be It Hereby Resolved, that the Whitewater Township Board reaffirms the action taken by the Whitewater Township Board at its regular meeting held on February 19, 1985 allowing appeals to be accepted in writing.
