RESOLUTION #10-15

Resolution for Ambulance Personnel Wages

Whitewater Township
Grand Traverse County, Michigan

Be It Resolved, that the wage for responses to emergency incidents to paid per run ambulance volunteers will be as follows, effective June 14, 2010, with payment to be issued bi-weekly.

1. A member of Whitewater Township Ambulance Service, who possesses minimum certification of MFR (Medical First Responder), shall receive on of the following wages:
 - a. \$18.00 shall be paid per emergency response and \$9.00 per hour after the first two (2) hours worked.
 - b. \$36.00 shall be paid per ambulance transport and \$9.00 per hour after the first four (4) hours worked.
2. An ambulance service member who is a trainee, approved by the township board for membership and currently working toward minimum certification as documented to the township board, shall be paid \$9.00 per emergency response/transport or the minimum hourly wage, whichever of the two is greater.
3. A maximum of three (3) personnel shall be paid for an ambulance transport unless extraordinary circumstances create additional needs.
4. Training/vehicle/equipment testing & maintenance, required meetings, public education/service shall be paid at an hourly rate of \$9.00 per hour.
5. An ambulance trainee, currently working toward minimum certification as documented to the township board, shall be paid the minimum hourly was for training, vehicle/equipment testing & maintenance, required meetings and public education/service.

A motion to adopt the foregoing resolution was made by Benak and seconded by Hubbell.
